

Dorchester Services for F. P. Sheehan

Funeral mass for Frank P. Sheehan, deputy superintendent of Boston school buildings and a former Olympic track star, was conducted yesterday morning at St. William's Church, Dorchester. Burial was in Brookdale Cemetery, Dedham.

Celebrant of the mass was the Rev. Peter F. Hart. The Rev. John J. McMahon was deacon, and the Rev. George F. Murray sub-deacon. Also present were the Revs. James Sheehan and the Rev. Mark Keohane.

Mr. Sheehan died Wednesday. An employe of the school building department more than 42 years, he had been an early protege of Jack Ryder, famed running coach.
